As of April 1st, 2023, there will be changes to the way we accept and process different COSHH & Non-Conforming waste at GBN Services Ltd, for these types of waste we require them to be removed from our site by a licenced waste contractor for the associated type of waste.

## EA POPs Compliance & Upholstered Domestic Furniture

You may have heard in the media the Environmental Agency is taking action on items containing POPs ensuring they are properly destroyed. These items are typically found in upholstered domestic furniture items. We must begin separating these items from our bins to avoid cross contamination. If you think your waste contains POPs related items, please contact us and we can provide a quotation for safe disposal of the items.

We often see a wide variety of items through our waste transfer stations many of which we cannot process for reasons related to the item. We must take positive action to remove these from the waste stream (treating them separately if applicable), store them correctly and safely, and then have them removed from our site by a competent and licenced waste contractor for the type of waste.
